The Department of Pharmaceutical Health Services Research (PHSR) at the University of Maryland, School of Pharmacy seeks candidates for a 12-month, non-tenure track Research Assistant Professor position in pharmaceutical health services research. The candidate will have opportunities to teach and serve on committees at the Department and School level. The candidate will report to the Chair of the Pharmaceutical Health Services Research Department.

The successful candidate is expected to support 85% of his or her salary and effort with externally funded grants and contracts. The remaining (15%) salary will be supported by the Department's Pharmaceutical Research Computing Center (PRC). Responsibilities include extending PRC analytic capabilities and assisting the PRC Director administratively.

Qualifications for the position include an earned doctorate with experience in epidemiology, biostatistics or related fields; excellent interpersonal/oral/written communication skills; exceptionally strong empirical skills and expertise with statistical software packages. The candidate will be expected to have current and ongoing grant/contract funding to support 85% of their salary.
