Qualifications

PhD, ScD, or DrPH in epidemiology, economics, health policy, social sciences, or health-services research is required. Clinical degree (PharmD, DPN, MD, DO or DPN) with research training is considered. Excellent communication, organizational, inter-personal, and time-management skills are a must. Research experience is desired. Knowledge of SAS, R, and SQL, or data visualization software required.
