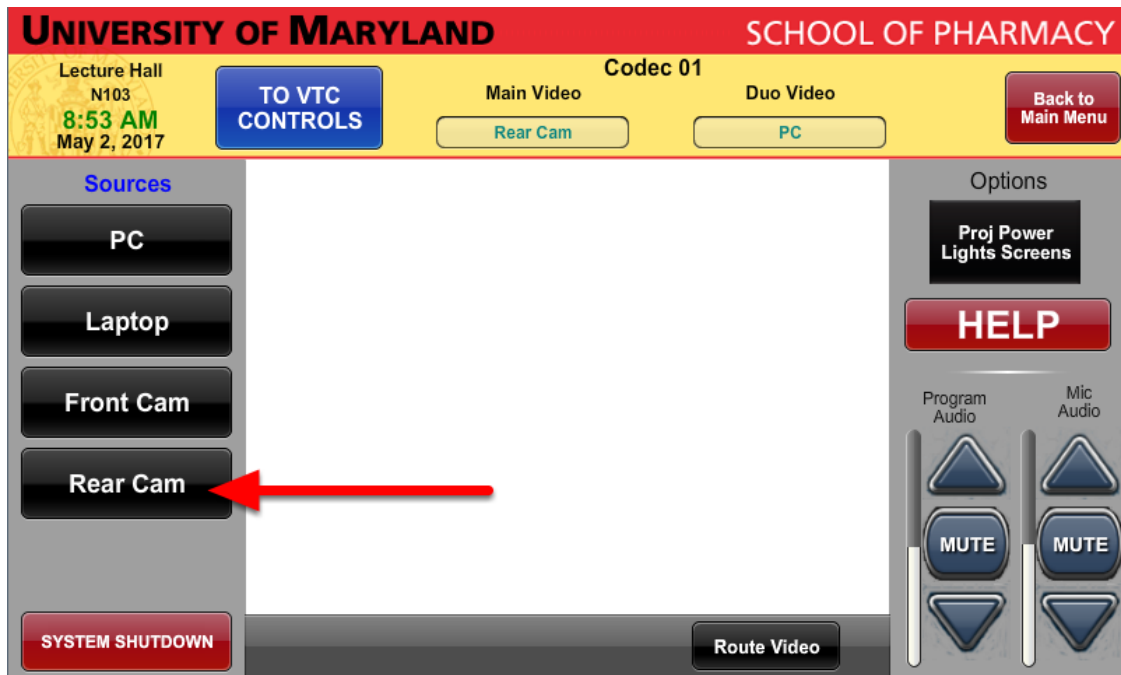


Moving the Camera

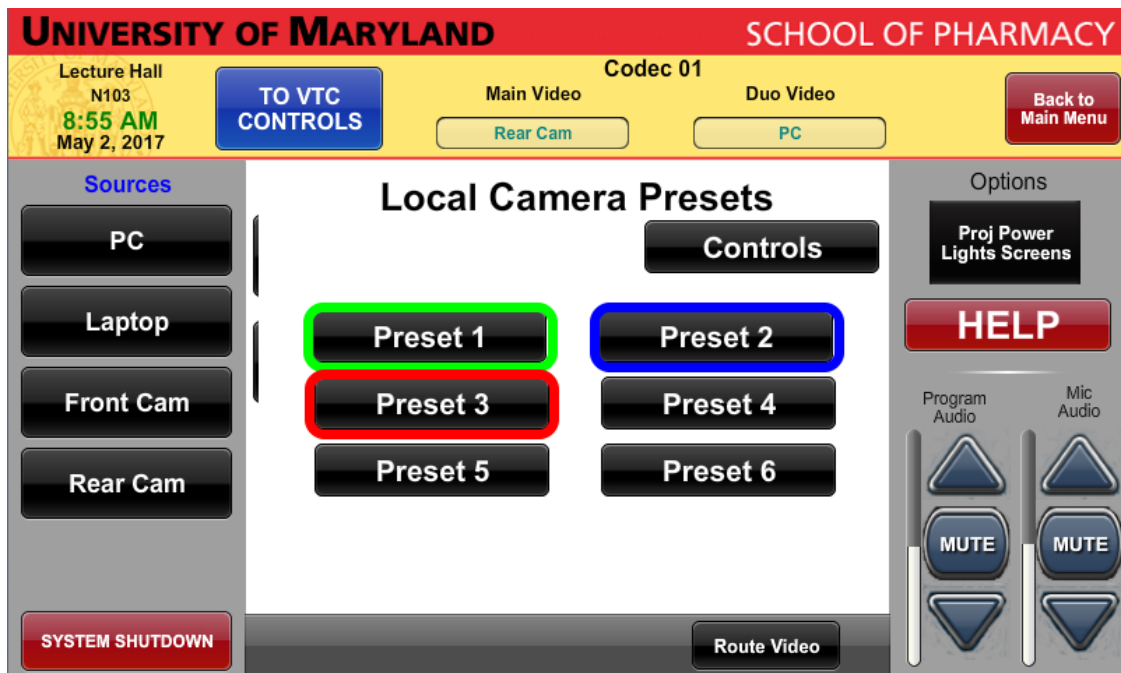


In order to move the camera, first choose the camera you want to move. Most likely, you will be using the rear camera. Press the button labeled "Rear Cam".

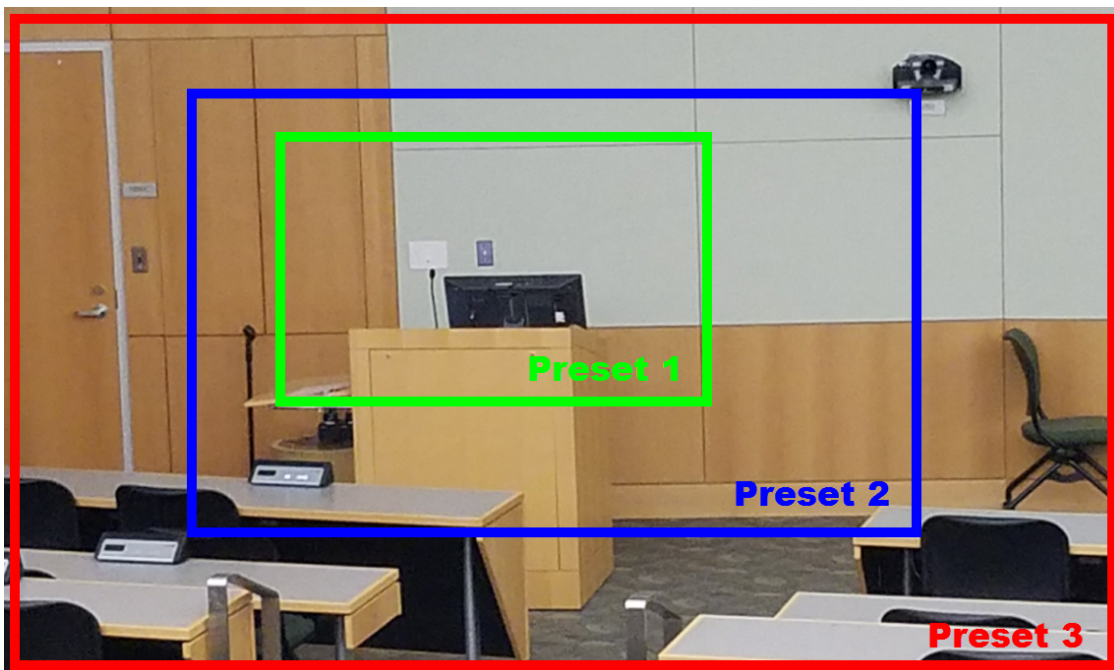


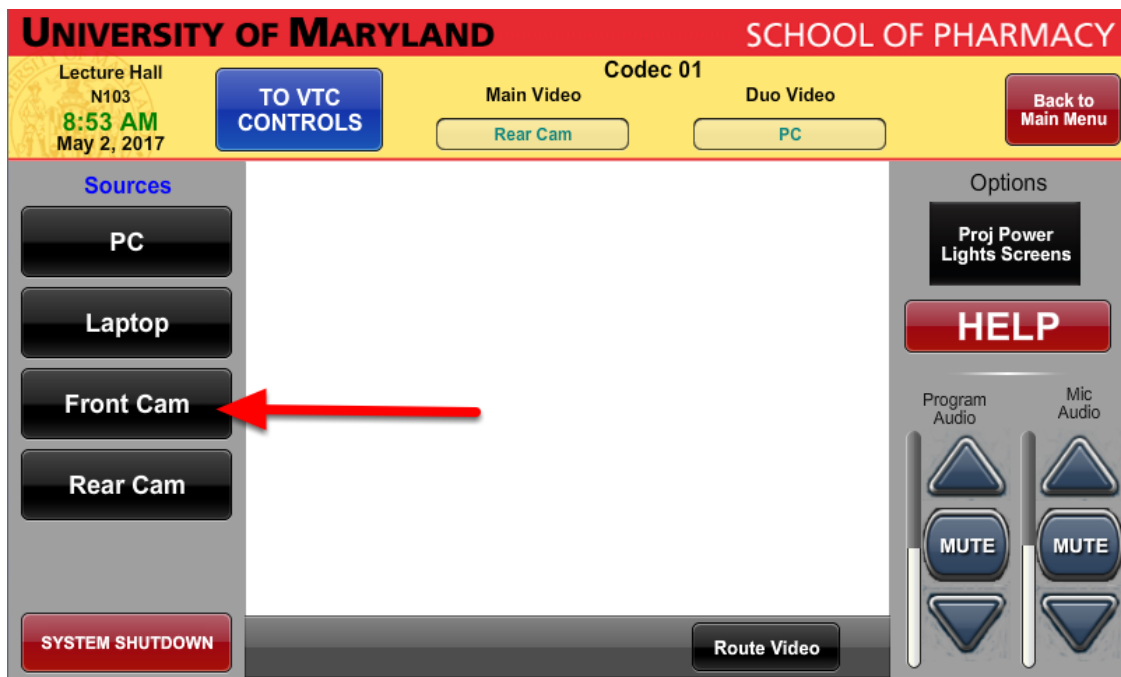
The rear camera screen gives you several options for camera movement. You can zoom in and out (1), pan or tilt the camera left and right or up and down with the directional wheel (2), or choose one of the preset camera locations under the "Presets" menu (3).

Presets

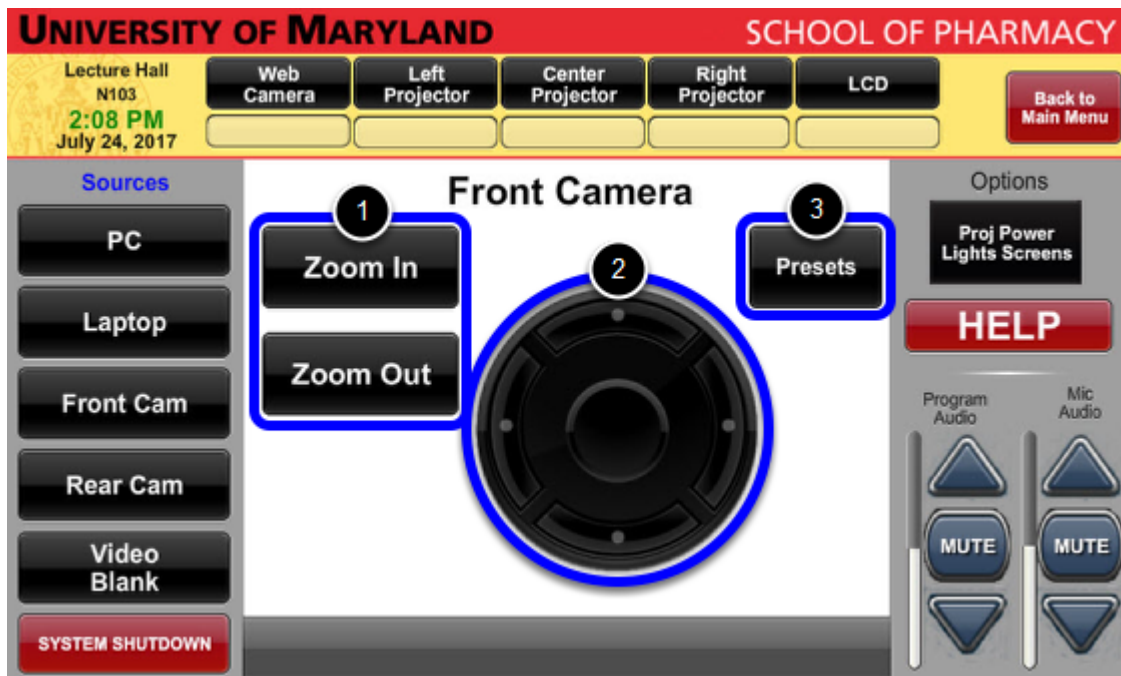


Here you can choose one of the preset camera locations. Preset 1 will be a close-up of the person speaking at the podium. Preset 2 is a medium shot of the podium. Preset 3 is a wider view of the podium area. Preset 4 is a wide shot of the lecture hall.

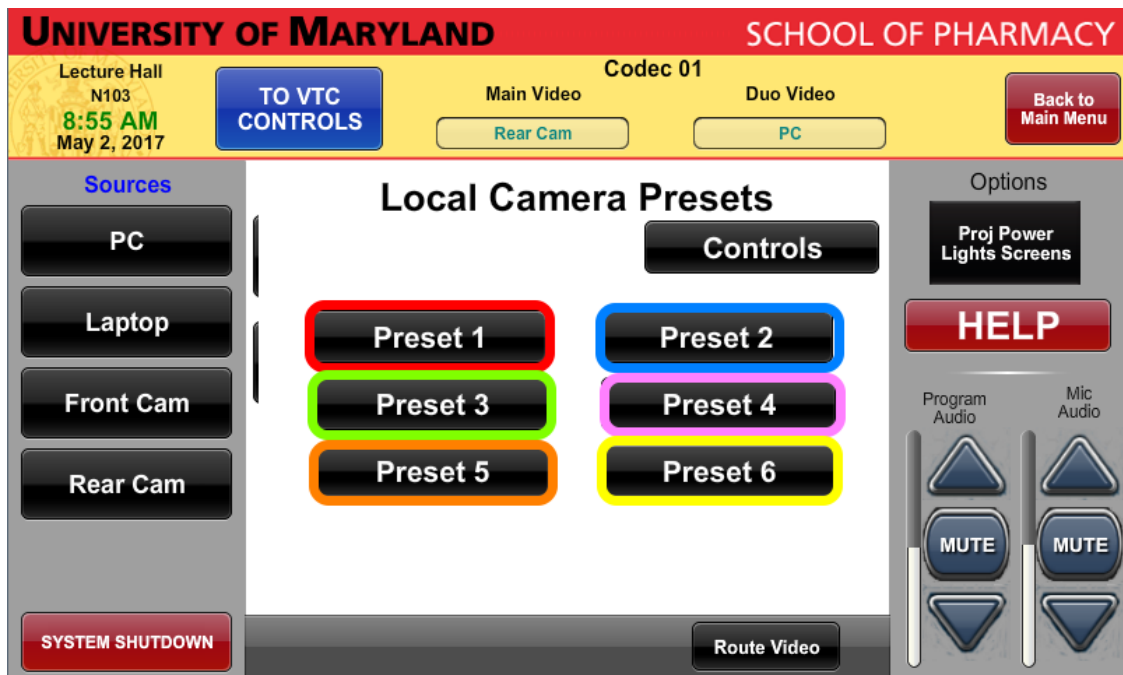




For the camera to face the audience, press the "Front Cam" button..



You can zoom in and out (1), pan or tilt the camera left and right or up and down with the directional wheel (2), or choose one of the preset camera locations under the "Presets" menu (3).



Here you can choose one of the preset camera locations. Each preset will go zoom onto a different section of the audience, as shown below.
