# University of Maryland Center of Excellence in Regulatory Science and Innovation (M-CERSI)



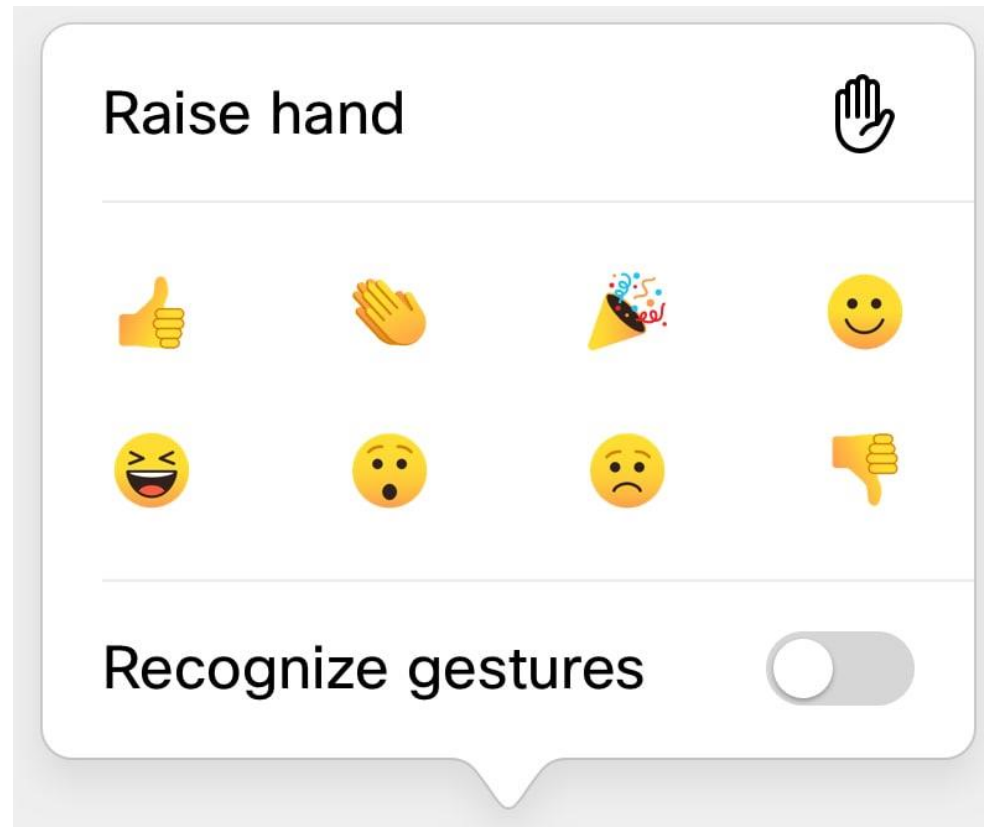

## How to raise hand in Webex?

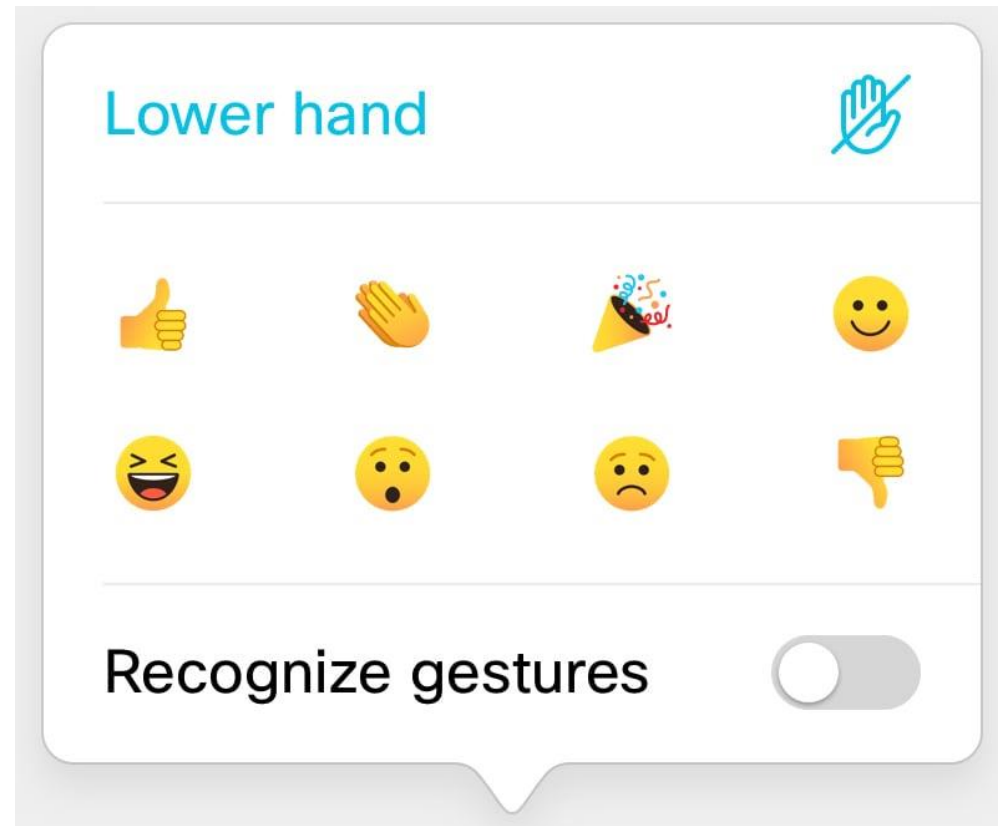
- At the bottom center of Webex, select the **React** button, , and tap **Raise hand**. Reaction button also available via **More** button  .
